Responsibilities of a Summer Junior Helper:

1. The Summer Junior Helper must be aware of the program prepared for their group and develop all the skills needed to give life to the program. These skills might include storytelling, singing, games, nature walks, and swimming. Be sure to speak with the teacher of your group before you begin each day to find out what they expect from you both inside the classroom and outdoors.
2. Help children from one activity to another with the teacher in charge of the group. When waiting is necessary it is important to be ready with a game, song, or activity.
3. Help the various instructors at all the specialized areas while your group is there.
4. The health and safety of the campers is always the first concern of the Summer Junior Helper and camp staff. Remember you must always act as an example for the campers with your own behavior. If you see a child who is in your group who is doing something that is unsafe, you must notify an adult.
5. Always be alert to possible hazards, notify an adult and make sure that all campers avoid them.
